Women have always been contributors to this magazine on various issues, and on more than one occasion have influenced my design concept all the way back to the drawing board. I was rather referring to the feminist ideal typified in art and design which first broke cover in the 1960s, and which is now part of mainstream conversation. If there has ever been any projection of male power in any of my work until now, or even any contrived likeness of discrimination, then I owe every one of my patrons an apology.

Feminism in the art and design world was important as it transformed cultural attitudes and shattered stereotypes. Art is not merely aesthetic escapism, but a tool to incite viewers to question the social and political landscape. Art was therefore a form of dialogue, and one which needed to include the woman's perspective. Feminism played an important role in de-glamourizing abstract expressionism which was so typical of the male dominated world. Women also brought in new techniques, materials and ideas into their work. It was the feminine venture that broke the rigidity of tradition, and expanded the definition of art to include wider and more nuanced perspectives

So I concluded that any lack of a participatory design paradigm would inevitably entail overlooking women's needs, wants and preferences. And art and design are two sides of the same coin. In the modern world, their ability of change cognition and rewire our thinking to form new habits are beyond comprehension. Gender roles almost certainly come into play in the depiction of art and design, in spite of every effort to contain it. That is why a designer must be sensitive to not convey a wrong impression or exclude someone from his concept. That in itself is the worst form of prejudice.

I now invite you to browse the following pages, as my toil and intervention have worked tirelessly to overcome many biological shortcomings. I hope this effort would rehabilitate our cognitive biases, and hark upon a different utopia in a world far removed from our own.






